Reading

Writing

All pupils will take part in a Puppet Theatre project, involving creating, performing and appraising puppet shows.



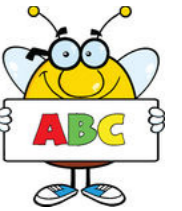
Grammar

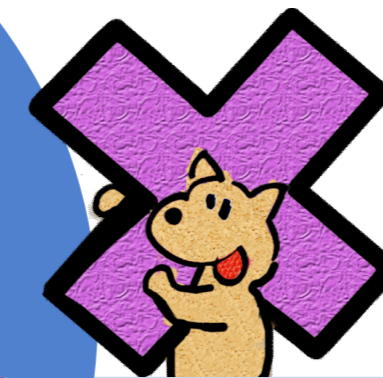
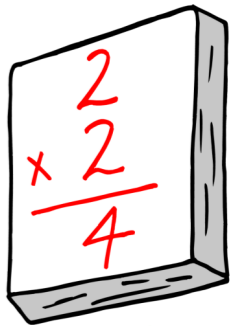

This period we are going to learn music notes on the Glockenspiel.



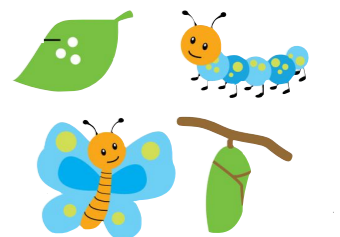
RME

The lessons in our rainforest topic are heavily linked to science this period. We will look at the lifecycle of the butterfly and frog before exploring food chains and the water cycle.



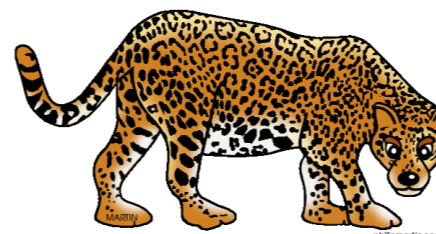
Technologies
