Information for Parents - Outline Plan for Learning and Teaching

Topic / Project Title: - Ancient Egyptians

Context relevant to the children: Pupils have expressed a particular interest in comparing this ancient civilisation to our own modern day life.

Languages

Reading — We will be learning about the features of non-fiction texts and continuing with our group reading discussions and comprehension.

Writing – We will focus on personal writing and improving our punctuation skills.

Listening and Talking — We will be listening and discussing audio/video on Ancient Egyptians.

Spelling and Grammar - We will continue to learn our `P3 phonics and will revise parts of speech such as nouns, verbs and adjectives.

French – We will be revising and building on our knowledge of numbers, days of the week and months etc

Numeracy and Mathematics

Numeracy - Mrs Leonard will focus on numbers to 1000 and beyond, writing the numbers before and after, sequencing and counting in steps of 2, 3, 4, 5, and 10 before introducing place value.

Addition - Mrs McCabe will focus on addition to 100 and beyond for some. Please help your child at home by practising number facts to 20.



We will also look at the Ancient Egyptian number system for some problem solving and enjoyment!
