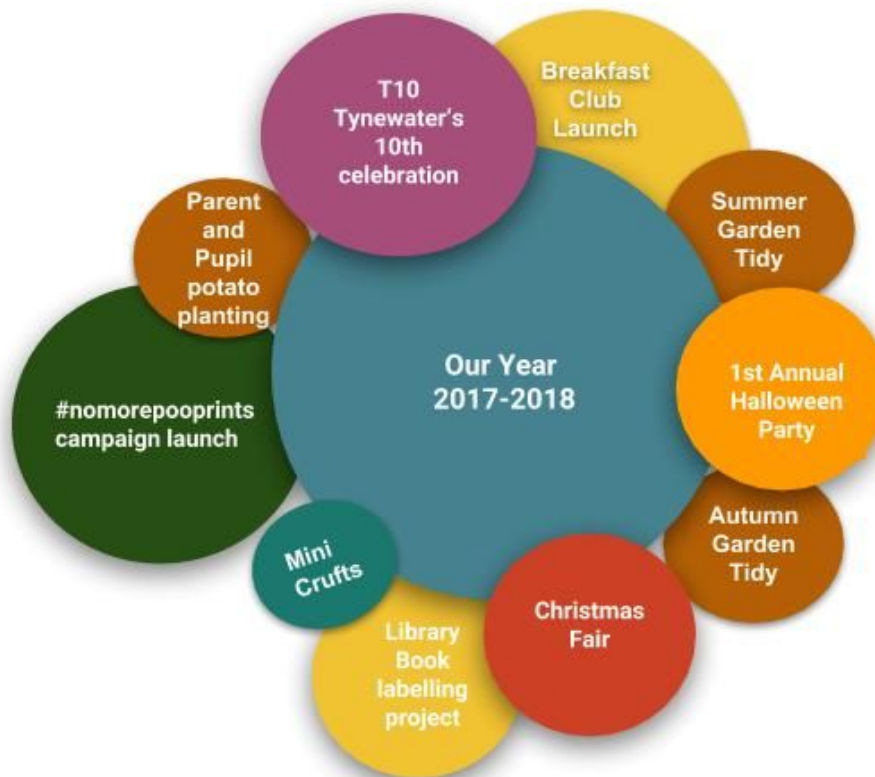




We've achieved so much last year by staff, pupils, families and community working together!

Our mission is to work with the entire community to help provide the best possible school experience for EVERY pupil at Tynewater Primary School and Nursery.

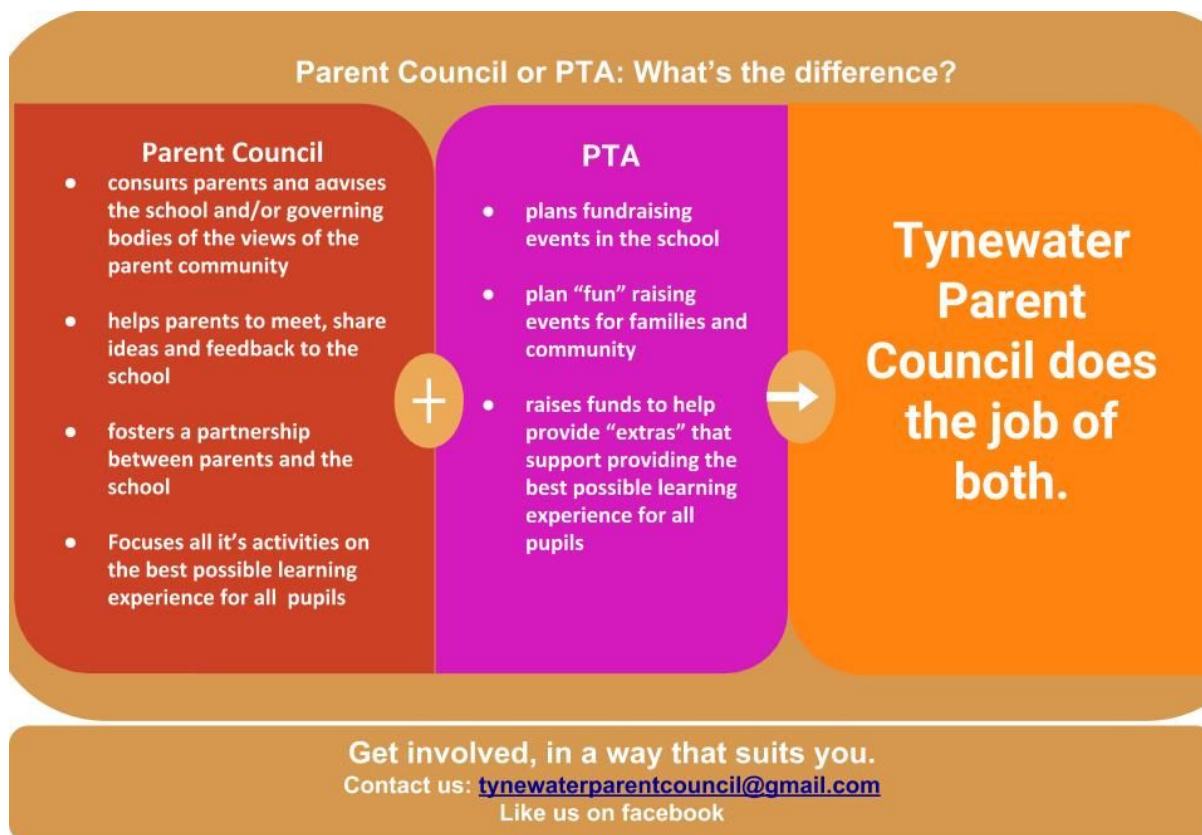
