Literacy & English

Reading

Enjoyment and learning how to engage with the Accelerated Reader Writing. We will focus on programme. Each pupil will have a personal reading target, linked to books of their choice.



Writing


Primary 4 will continue to use digital technology in our classroom to enhance our lessons. Additionally, we will focus on the design
